

## Potential Birds Around Logan Lake

The following list of birds includes ones that are most likely to be seen in the Logan Lake area, depending upon time of year and habitats visited. Some are residents, others are migrants, winter visitors or just summer visitors only. Some are confirmed but not necessarily all, although all of these species occur in the general Kamloops area. The best all round list of birds for our general area is the checklist prepared at the following website. <http://www.lljr.ca/>

The following subset of birds includes the ones most likely to be in the Logan Lake area on a regular basis, including Mamit Lake. Others could occur for sure, especially during migration. The more habitats you visit, the larger the number of species that you will see.

We have listed 164 species but depending upon how far afield you go, this could increase if you include some habitat for sandpipers that would not normally occur at Logan Lake (the lake). Mud flats at the end of Mamit Lake at the right time of year could attract shorebirds and sandpipers.
