"BLUE BAG RECYCLING PROGRAM"

The Thompson-Nicola Regional District (TNRD) is implementing a new Blue Bag Recycling Program in Logan Lake, which includes the recycling of clean and dry materials in a transparent blue garbage bag.

All the materials listed below can be placed in the same blue bag. The blue bags can be disposed of in the designated green bins at our local transfer station or you can simply empty the contents and reuse the blue bag. There is no sorting required.

Acceptable Materials include:

Metals (clean tin cans, aluminum pie plates)

Paper (all types including newsprint, magazines, books, loose paper, and

Boxboard and Heavy Paper (cereal and food boxes, brown envelopes, egg cartons)

Plastics (all plastics including types 1 through 7 e.g. household bottles and containers, milk jugs, ice cream pails, clean plastic bags and film.

GLASS and CORRUGATED CARDBOARD do not go in the blue bags but are accepted in separate bins at the transfer station.

Blue bags can be purchased at both Highland Valley Foods as well as the Logan Lake IDA Drug Mart.
