Search and Rescue Teams in British Columbia are composed of some 4000 volunteers province wide and participate in approximately 1000 searches per year. Not all these searches occur in the wilderness. Urban searches occur for Alzheimer's patients, missing children and police evidence searches. Search and Rescue also assists in road control during fires, floods, or in evacuations during any civic emergency. Each Search and Rescue group in British Columbia is 100% self supported. Each group is responsible for their own equipment, transportation, and any resources required to perform the rescue tasks. Logan Lake is fortunate to have an active group within the community composed of approximately 20 search members, supported by an additional 8 Ham Radio operators who supply field communications.
