



NOTICE

2018 WATER REGULATIONS

Please be advised that effective May 28, 2018 water usage will be in effect as follows:

WATERING HOURS:

Odd numbered civic addresses may water on **odd numbered days**; AND **even numbered civic addresses** may water on **even numbered days**

NOTE: if your watering day is an even number day; you are not permitted to overlap your watering into an odd number day and vice versa.

- 5:00am – 9:00am or 6:00pm – 10:00pm
- Additionally: Automatic Irrigation is permitted between 6:00pm – 9:00am when using a timer on your designated days

OTHER WATER USES: All hoses used outdoors should be equipped with a working spring-loaded shut-off device. Hand watering of plants using a hose with a spring-loaded shut-off nozzle or a hand-held container is permitted at any time. Water customers are encouraged to use irrigation materials consisting of drip type systems with timers.

BENEFITS OF WATER CONSERVATION: Some benefits of practicing water conservation include:

- Reduced wear, increased life of water service results in lower utility costs for taxpayers.
- Less need to increase the capacity of infrastructure to meet the water demands, delays expensive capital expansion costs to residents.
- More likely that full water reservoir capacities will be available in the event of an emergency.
