Volunteers for Citizens on Patrol and Speed Watch Programs

Working in teams and using marked vehicles, volunteers drive through local neighbourhoods observing and reporting on any criminal or suspicious activity. Citizens on Patrol (COP) volunteers serve as extra eyes and ears that assist in deterring crime. COP volunteers never interact in any potentially criminal or dangerous situation. COP volunteers report all suspicious and criminal activity they observe.

For the Speed Watch program, volunteers set up clearly marked speed boards in areas where motorists are known to speed. The volunteers record the licence plate numbers of those going over the posted speed limit, and forward the information to the RCMP.

Anyone interested in becoming a COP or Speed Watch volunteer must submit a completed registration form and a read and accept the Citizens on Patrol Code of Conduct.
