Your library system operates 13 branches and a Bookmobile to meet your needs. Library branches vary by size of collection and by range of services according to the size of community they serve.

HOW TO GET A CARD

Apply for your free card at any library branch or at the Bookmobile. Remember to bring proof of identification and proof of current local address.

Parents assume responsibility for items borrowed by their children. Parents are required to sign a statement of responsibility at the time of registration.

If you live outside of the Thompson-Nicola Regional District, you may use our services upon payment of a non-resident's fee.

Library Services

for children

Our branches provide materials for children from pre-school to junior high. Programs vary from branch to branch. Programs may include pre-school story hours, summer reading clubs, craft programs, group tours and school visits.

for teenagers

Young Adult books, magazines, DVDs, videos, books on CD, music CDs and graphic novels are found at most branches and on the Bookmobile.

for seniors

A collection of Large Print books is available at all branches for those who find large print easier to read. Full length and abridged books are available on cassette tape and CD.

for the homebound

Library materials may be delivered to homebound patrons living in the City of Kamloops.

If we are unable to supply a book from our own collection, material may be borrowed from other libraries in the province or from across Canada through our interlibrary loan service.

Genealogy

Library patrons are eligible to borrow microfilm from a variety of institutions at no cost.
