

Subject: LE Bird Count 2011-2016

The July 4 +16, 2011 bird count was taken prior to Lake Enhancement Wetland Project Phase 1. May 28 & July 5, 2015 was taken prior to Phase 3 and April 30, 2016 prior to Phase 4. The numbers for April 2016 are low because not all birds have arrived to nest. The shrubs and trees are usually not fully leafed until mid to late May even though the the lakes and ponds have been ice free since the beginning of April.
