



Regular Council Meeting Highlights

April 6 & 20, 2021

1. Council awarded the contract to complete construction of Ironstone Ridge Residential Subdivision, Phase 3B, to Rivermist Excavating at a cost of \$639,841.53 (inclusive of tax) allowing the remainder of the project money (total project budget of \$850,000) to be allocated towards contingency and Phase 3C development;
2. Council approved a Rental Agreement with the Logan Lake Athletic Club as presented for the weight room within the Recreation Centre;
3. Council approved the contract be awarded to Bree Contracting Ltd. to complete construction of Well 5 including the submitted optional items for a total of \$707,772.45 (inclusive of tax);
4. Council awarded Connectivity Comparison Plan to Planetworks Consulting; and an additional \$9,000 be budgeted for the Comparison Plan report;
5. Council awarded the contract for the replacement of pick-up truck #21 to Metro Motors Ltd. for \$45,416.00 taxes included;
6. Council approved that Staff consider creating a small dog park at Marie King Park and return with proposals for Council's consideration;
7. Council approved that a letter be sent to the City of Penticton in support of their letter to the Union of BC Municipalities regarding the BC Government's Use of Provincial Paramountcy to Undermine Local Government Bylaws;
8. Council authorized District staff respond to letters from the HVOA from Mike and Kathy Nikischer advising that Council is in receipt of their letters; and that their concerns are being taken under advisement;
9. Council authorized District staff to send out a public thank you to the Community for successful vaccine clinic participation;
10. Council approved the late Grant-in-Kind application from the LLWHY for \$7,000 for the Summer Discovery Camp Program;
11. Council adopted TV Society Grant-in-Aid Frontage Tax Bylaw No. 872, 2021.

Special Council Annual Budget Meeting Highlights

April 13, 2021

1. Council approved an increase to the Water Utility rates by 3% in 2021;
2. Council approved Contribution to Reserves for the Sewer Operating Fund of \$110,800 from the sewer operating fund surplus;
3. Council approved an increase to the sewer utility rates by 1.3% in 2021;
4. Council approved an increase to the solid waste & recycling rates by 1.8% in 2021;
5. Council approved an additional \$4,000 annually to implement broadcasting the District's Regular Council Meetings;
6. Council approved \$20,000 for a custom website update and consolidation of the Logan Lake websites;
7. Council approved \$25,000 in 2021 to complete all highlighted items pertaining to Municipal Hall Project Finishing Touches;
8. Council approved \$21,000 + GST in the 2021 budget for the supply and installation of Lennox ductless split A/C system in the Fire Hall; and that the project be awarded to Twin River Plumbing and Heating;
9. Council approved \$2,000 for the livestreaming of the Canada Day Fireworks Display;
10. Council approved the purchase of the Cobra Firing System at a cost of \$7,500; and that \$7,500 be added to the Canada Day Budget;
11. Council approved Grant-in-Kind request from the Logan Lake Grad Class 2021 in the amount of \$1,018.50 for the use of the Recreation Centre;
12. Council approved Grant-in-Aid for a grant from the Kamloops Amateur Radio Club in the amount of \$2,792.20 to be used for Capital Purposes;
13. Council approved Grant-in-Kind request from Logan Lake Lacrosse in the amount of \$6,244.88 for use of the Recreation Centre;
14. Council approved 2021 annual funding to the Logan Lake WHY in the amount of \$45,300 subject to a revised operating budget due to COVID-19;
15. Council approved the combined Campground Manager and Campground Host roles as a seasonal contract, separated from the Community Development Officer/Visitor Information Centre Manager/Event Planner role, and budgeted \$21,000 for this service;
16. Council approved the allocation of \$60,000 in 2021 to build a double walled polycarbonate greenhouse;
17. Council approved \$84,000 be taken from Surplus and placed in the Road Reserve;
18. Council approved \$16,200 be taken from Surplus and placed in the Parks Reserve;
19. Council approved \$5,000 be taken from the Banner Reserve and placed in the Parks Reserve;
20. Council approved \$200,000 be taken from Surplus and placed into the Cemetery Reserve;
21. Council approved an increase to the municipal property tax rates by 1.8% in 2021.
