



Council Meeting Highlights
 September 21, 2021

1. Council approved 2021 Grant-in-Kind Application from LL Lions requesting the use of the Curling Rink, tables and chairs for the Logan Lake Community Groups Info Day on October 2, 2021 subject to COVID-19 Guidelines;
2. Council approved the request from the Regional District of Mount Waddington regarding a challenge to all Local Governments to contribute one dollar (\$1) for every resident in their community to help rebuild the Village of Lytton and that the District of Logan Lake participate in the challenge;
3. Council approved the letter of support from Gold Country BC for their application for the Fairs Festivals Events Recovery Fund from the Province of BC for the Gold Country GeoTour Prequel event and launch in August 2022;
4. Council approved the DRAFT letter from the Lake Enhancement Working Group be sent to the Ministry of Transportation and Infrastructure;
5. Council approved the Community Development Officer contact the LL WHY to help with coordination of the 50th Anniversary Celebration Events; and that the LL WHY get back to the District with a cost for assisting with the event;
6. Council approved Logan Lake 50th Anniversary Celebration be held on June 30, July 1, 2, and 3, 2022;
7. Council approved a scope and estimate be obtained from Vesta Giles for the creation of a book regarding the 2021 Tremont Creek Wildfire and FireSmart in the District of Logan Lake;
8. Council appointed Joan Saunders and Lawrence Hart as voting members on the 50th Anniversary Committee; and Karley Millhouse, Sandy Soul, and Nadia Ward as Alternate Voting Members;
9. Council awarded the time sensitive paving of a portion of Jasper Drive to Peter Brothers Construction Ltd. for \$57,000 + GST;
10. Council referred to budget the discussion of outdoor sinks in the Campground at a cost of \$2,500.
