



Council Meeting Highlights
October 2021

1. Council approved a Committee of the Whole meeting be scheduled for a one-day workshop prior to the First Quarter to review and update the current Strategic Plan including the Economic Development Strategy, the Business Retention and Expansion program and the Marketing Strategy to reflect current needs;
2. Council issued a temporary permit for Woods Smoking BBQ Pit for October 6th and 13th at a suitable location within the Public Mall Area;
3. Council approved that Staff review District of Logan Lake Zoning Bylaw 675, 2010 and Business Licence Bylaw 718, 2013 for Mobile Vending businesses within the District of Logan Lake; and report back to Council;
4. Council gave first, second and third reading to Permissive Tax Exemption Bylaw No. 877, 2021.
5. Council requested staff provide a copy of Regular Council Meeting Outstanding Assignments to the upcoming Strategic Planning Session and to the next Budget meeting; and that a copy be provided to Council on a quarterly basis;
6. Council approved that District does not proceed with the paving of Jasper Drive in 2021;
7. Council approved that the Campground Road Realignment Sketch and a letter be sent to the Golf Course for comments and report back to Council;
8. Council approved that the District of Logan Lake 2021 Roadway Data Collection and Pavement Management Plan be forwarded to Budget for further discussion and consideration;
9. Council approved that the Director of Public Works and Recreation report on the efficiency of the Kitchen area and that the report be sent to the PWPR Committee for review and recommendations;
10. Council approved a virtual Remembrance Day Ceremony similar to last year's event and that the event budget be increased to \$3,000;
11. Council supported the 2022 Community Resiliency Investment Program Grant Application in the amount of \$121,150.00 as prepared by Forsite Consulting and the Fire Chief;
12. Council approved the Concession Lease Agreement at the Recreation Centre with the Logan Lake Minor Hockey Association for the 2021/2022 season;
13. Council approved the transfer of \$20,000 from the Gravel Pit Reserve to complete any required consultations related to the Mammette Lake Gravel Pit expansion;
14. Council approved that a letter and promotional items be sent to the Copper Valley Fat Quarters Quilt Guild thanking them for their presentation of the 50th Anniversary Banner;
15. Council adopted Permissive Tax Exemption Bylaw No. 877, 2021;
16. Council authorized the calling of a Public Hearing to consider amending the C-1 Town Centre Commercial Zone to accommodate a Church in the case of Lot 1, Plan KAS1302, DL 1666, KDYD (220 Opal Drive);
17. Council gave first and second reading to Logan Lake Zoning Amendment Bylaw 878, 2021.

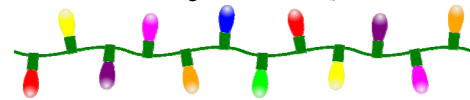

Virtual Remembrance Day Ceremony 2021

Live-Streaming Due to COVID-19

As per Provincial regulations regarding gatherings during COVID-19 this year's ceremony will be altered as follows:

Operating a Wood Stove

The key to maintaining a good fire is careful control of the air supply, which determines how completely the fuel is burned.

Excessive smoke from a chimney in the middle of a burn is a sign of incomplete combustion and creates problems. Some smoke should be visible when you light the fire, but for the remainder of the burn it should be almost invisible. If the smoke doesn't burn in the firebox, it will go up the chimney and form flammable creosote deposits that can lead to a chimney fire, or lead to air pollution.

Please use safe burning practices when using your wood burning stove.
